

PROCEDURE FOR BEDBUG TREATMENT

- 1. Mattresses, if too infested, must be disposed of and replaced by new ones. Do not bring new mattresses into the house until all treatments have been rendered. Please leave new mattresses in plastic for four (4) weeks.**
- 2. All linen, bedding & clothing near the beds must be washed and dried in hot cycles. Please keep clothes stored in black heavy duty bags until all services are performed.**
- 3. Entire apt. must be vacuumed. (Steam vacuumed where possible). Bag from vacuum must be “re-bagged” & disposed of immediately.**
- 4. Furniture and other objects must be separated from walls at least six inches.**
- 5. Discard all cardboard boxes, shoe boxes, old magazines, newspapers, plastic & paper bags (de-clutter, de-clutter, de-clutter).**
- 6. Food must be covered.**
- 7. Please remove all electrical outlet & light switch plate covers, so that our technicians may pump powder into the outlets**
- 8. Technician shall apply insecticides as follows:**
 - a) Residual chemicals to bedrooms & living room.**
 - b) Spot application of a hand held aerosol for hard to get areas.**
 - c) Growth regulators to stop breeding.**
 - d) Powder (dusts) to outlets. Please note, customer is responsible for removing & replacing outlet covers in bedrooms & living room.**
- 9. Open windows and air out apartment after technician is done.**
- 10. Apartment must be vacated for three (3) hours after service is done.**
- 11. Mattress encasements are strongly recommended. You can also purchase these from us, includes free delivery.**
- 12. Do not put clothing back in draws or closets until six (6) days after follow up service.**

Non-compliance with these procedures render guarantee null and void.
